I would like to thank the Aquaculture Advisory Council for providing DG MARE with its Recommendation on the Specific Protection of Shellfish Water Quality.

In parallel, the Fitness check on the Water Framework Directive, its associated Directives and the Floods Directive, has been published. These concluded that the legislation is overall fit for purpose, albeit with some room for enhanced effectiveness.
