Elements concerning funding for research included in the Commission's response:

- Climate issues related to aquaculture are also in the scope of **Horizon Europe** Cluster 6 Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment.
- The **EMFAF** may provide funding for animal health monitoring of shellfish stocks and for improving shellfish water quality directly linked to good health of the shellfish if they are included in the national programmes, and in accordance with the eligibility rules defined by the MS.



Update on the Urban Wastewater treatment Directive negotiations:

The European Commission tabled its proposal on 26 October 2022, as part of a zero-pollution legislative package.

Draft report by MEP Torvalds presented in COM ENVI on 26 April 2023. Deadline for amendments: 5 May. Indicative vote in Plenary: October 2023.

A policy debate took place at the Environment Council on 16 March 2023. No general approach yet.


